#### **Sports Seasons**

Saint Joseph Catholic School offers the following competitive sports for grades 5 through 8.

Fall	Girls Volleyball	August-October
Winter	Boys Basketball	October-December
Winter	Girls Basketball	January-March
Spring	Track and Field	April-May

There is also a Cheerleading Team open to all girls in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> grades. There is a \$25 fee, which will be used to cover the costs of uniform purchases and uniform replacements.

#### **Athletic Fees**

The athletic fee for each sport is listed below. Our athletic fees help to cover the cost of officials and referees, NCIL league dues, equipment and uniforms, and coach's stipends. Fees are billed directly to your FACTS account once the season begins.

Volleyball: \$90 Basketball: \$90 Track and Field: \$90 Cheerleading: \$25

#### **Athletic Eligibility**

In order to participate in athletics, students must have an updated physical and a signed Athletic Participation Form on file. These forms can be turned into the front office or to the Athletic Director.

At Saint Joseph Catholic School, academics and exemplary behavior are two of our top priorities. Students will be placed on the academically ineligible list if they have more than one "D" and/or an "F" in any subject area.

Grade reports will be generated by the Athletic Director every Thursday morning. Any student-athlete appearing on the ineligible list will remain ineligible to participate until the following Thursday when a new report is generated.

If a student-athlete receives a Student Conduct Report for major violations (such as insubordination, fighting, destruction of school property) they will be deemed behaviorally ineligible to participate in the next scheduled game.

If a student is absent from school on a particular date, they are not eligible to participate in any practice or game on that day.

#### Communication

Communication will be primarily through email and the band app. If you need to contact the Athletic Director, please email Mr. Garcia at the following address: tgarcia@gosaintjoseph.org

#### **Registration/Tryouts**

Registration for each sport should occur prior to the official start of each season. Without the proper paperwork completed, an athlete will not be allowed to participate. While all sports at Saint Joseph are non-cut sports, athletes will be placed on a team that is appropriate for their level of skill. Coaches and the Athletic Director will determine the level of play for each student-athlete. The number of teams fielded will be determined by the number of athletes we have for each sport.

#### **Transportation**

It is the responsibility of the athlete and the parents to arrange transportation to and from practices and games. Athletes may ride to games and home with a parent or another adult **if that adult is included on the transportation permission sheet signed by the parent.** Any adult providing rides to athletes other than their own child must have completed all of the volunteer requirements.

#### **Equipment**

Each athlete is responsible for all the equipment s/he is issued. A uniform check out/in will be conducted at the beginning and end of each season. If the equipment is not returned to the coach/Athletic Director, the athlete/family will be expected to reimburse the school for replacement costs. The athlete will not be able to participate in another sport until this responsibility is taken care of.

#### Parent and Athlete meeting

A mandatory parent/athlete meeting will be held at the beginning of each sports season. This meeting shall occur on the first Tuesday of each season, at the conclusion of practice. Families are expected to send an adult representative to this meeting. The objectives of these meetings are as follows:

- Introduce coaches
- Discuss team rules, game and practice procedures
- Discuss safety and medical concerns
- Sign up to volunteer for home (and in some cases away) games/matches duties. Such duties include clock operator, scorekeeper, line judges. Our goal is that each family will serve to volunteer for at least one home game/match
- Review code of ethic

# Saint Joseph School Code of Ethics for Coaches, Player and Parents

#### 1. Coaches

- Be a positive role model for athletes, exemplifying the highest moral and ethical behavior
- Coach in a positive manner, reflecting our Christian values
- Instruct athletes in sportsmanship and hold them accountable for displaying outstanding sportsmanship
- Treat opposing coaches, athletes, and fans with dignity and respect
- Respect the judgment of officials and abide by the rules of the event

#### 2. Student-Athletes

- Be a positive role model, within the classroom, hallways, and on the athletic field
- Play in a positive manner, reflecting our Christian values
- Accept the responsibility of representing Saint Joseph by displaying exemplary behavior at all times
- Treat teammates, coaches, officials, opponents, and guests with dignity and respect

#### 3. Parents

- Behave in a positive manner, reflecting our Christian values
- Treat all coaches, athletes, officials, and administrators with dignity and respect
- Respect the judgment of officials and refrain from directing negative comments towards them
- Support and encourage full participation by your athlete in practice and game situations

#### 4. Issue Resolution Protocol

- If an athlete has an issue with a teammate or coach, they should first attempt to solve the issue by directly approaching the teammate or coach
- If a solution is not reached, parents should follow up directly with the coach
- If at that point, a resolution is not achieved, the athlete, parent, coach, and AD will meet to resolve the problem
- Any issue that is morally wrong or physically harmful should be communicated immediately to the Athletic Director and Principal
